Communication skill also increases learning, understanding, and encourages learning. Show how. Teach other than just learning Lecture. This will make the lesson memorized. Has increased from 5% to 90% (3)

Activity



Role-Playing in forensic teaching is a learning experience in each profession that works together in the justice movement, especially in the case of scene investigation.
