

# Win-win Co-learning through Online English Learning Media

## Introduction

Learners of English as a foreign language are not equally equipped with effective learning resources, instructors. The resource disadvantages especially for learners of English as a foreign language, especially in the rural areas, could currently be solved with the application of the modern online technology. However, the developed contents need good cooperation among the following parties: university lecturers, English major undergraduates and school teachers. Therefore, this project aims at exploring the possibility of applying the online learning platform to enhance both the undergraduates' as well as the primary students' English knowledge.



## Activities

- Divide students into 6 groups, each with an assigned advisor.
- Instruct each group to study the primary English Materials “Projects: Play & Learn” and design online learning materials to support English learning among weak primary students at Ban Sai-po School, an underprivileged primary school in a rural area of Naboan, Nakhoh Si Thammarat.
- Provide an opportunity for the students to visit the school to meet the primary students, discuss with the school teachers about the learning contents.
- Provide an opportunity for students to share their school visit experiences.
- Provide an opportunity for students to present their projects to the advisors and to school teachers for comments and recommendations.
- Provide an opportunity for students to run an English camp at the target school in order to demonstrate to the primary learners how to use the online learning materials on their own as well as to test the effectiveness of the online material output by administering a pre-test and a post test to the primary learners.

## Impacts

- Primary students' life-long English learning through today's availability of generous online resources.
- Undergraduates' self-monitoring and enhancement of their own English knowledge through the production of the primary English learning materials.

## Future Project Development

- Study the learning outcomes among the primary learners based on the differences between the pre-test and the post test scores.
